



The 5th Great Eccleston Bake-off Rules of Entry

The competition takes place at Eccleston Village Hall on Sunday 10th September. Entries must be brought to Eccleston Village Hall between 12.30 and 3pm that day. Judging by a panel of experts from St Helens WI will take place from 3.15pm to 3.45pm. The winner and runner-up will be announced at 4pm, when prizes and trophies will be awarded.

The entry must be a cake - no desserts or pies

The cake has to be baked - no refrigerated concoctions

It must be made from scratch - no shop-bought mixes or repackaged goods (shop-bought decorations are acceptable, but the cake/filling/topping must be homemade)

Do not reveal to anyone which cake is yours - entries are blind-tasted to ensure fairness

No intimidating fellow bakers or bribing the judges

Judges are not eligible to enter

Entries must be displayed with the small label featuring the cake's name and brief description. The completed entry form must be folded and placed beneath the plate/stand that your cake is on to preserve anonymity.

The type of cake you bake is up to you, but you must ensure that your description accurately reflects what type of cake it is. For instance, if it is described as a carrot cake, the judges will score it against the classic idea of a carrot cake's taste and texture, but if yours is a twist on a carrot cake and incorporates unexpected ingredients, please say so on the label so that the judges can take it into consideration.
